SUPREME NOVICES' HURDLE

- **FIREFOX** is the only horse to have beaten Ballyburn. MF That was on soft ground and we're starting on slow ground.
- MISTERGIF (each-way). He jumps like a gazelle and PMhas lots of speed.
- The race has been blown wide open with Ballyburn's NC defection to Wednesday's Gallaghers Hurdle. I like his stablemates MYSTICAL POWER & MISTERGIF to run big races now.
- There are only 12 declared and none are real tearaway RW front runner so TULLYHILL'S jumping mightn't come under as much pressure.
- I have long been a fan of JERIKO DU REPONET MC (each-way) and we get a price because the Nicky Henderson stable is under a cloud.

2.50pm

ULTIMA HANDICAP CHASE

- It looks like connections have protected **THE** MF GOFFER'S mark all season as we didn't see him until a two-mile stable yard 'challenge' race last month, where he ran out a convincing winner. He's primed to go close.
- The Paddy Power Chase winner PM **MEETINGOFTHEWATERS** is a young, progressive and exciting chaser.
- NC I fancy THE GOFFER, he's back on form to repeat a good run from last year.
- The boking of Harry Cobden catches the eye on RW TRELAWNE. Meeingofthewaters has his chance but the price has gone for me now.
- I've long been a supporter of CHIANTI CLASSICO MC (each-way). I loved the way he kept on at Kempton against a course specialist and he will get an aggressive ride from David Bass ride.

4.10pm

MARES' HURDLE

- Unoriginal I'm afraid, but LOSSIEMOUTH is the highest MF rated runner in the field and unless she gets very keen and runs herself into the ground she should be winning. Marie's Rock is definitely a contender at a price to be placed.
- **ASHROE DIAMOND** is bred to appreciate the ground PM and the trip. Unbeaten against her own sex over hurdles.
- I have to go with LOSSIEMOUTH, who was unbelievable NC last year in the Triumph Hurdle last season and again on her reappearance.
- This is all about **LOSSIEMOUTH** who was awesome on RW her comeback run.
- Of course LOSSIEMOUTH can bounce after one run MC following a long lay-off but she bolted up from Love Envoi last time and she's simply the class act against this lot.

2.10pm

ARKLE CHALLENGE TROPHY

- I'm going for a little bit of a surprise, **HUNTERS YARN**, MF who was very strong last time when winning at Fairyhouse. He looks a value bet.
- GAELIC WARRIOR is the best horse in the race and PMthe slow ground will help. The fact that he's jumping fences rather than hurdles may help to negate his preference for jumping right-handed at the obstacles.
- QUILIXIOS was back to form over fences in Naas and I NC think he'll run a big race.
- A small each-way stake on **MASTER CHEWY** in what RW is a head-scratcher of a race.
- GAELIC WARRIOR is the most talented horse in this MC race. If he gets into a rhythm out in front I don't think they will get near him.

3.30pm

CHAMPION HURDLE CHALLENGE TROPHY

- It is very hard to get away from STATE MAN as the MF most likely winner, especially with Lossiemouth going to the Mares' Hurdle. Iberico Lord could be one for the places.
- **STATE MAN** was runner up to Constitution Hill last PMyear in the Champion Hurdle and is unbeaten this season. Just look at his form.
- I think **STATE MAN** is a certainty. NC
- It's **STATE MAN**'s to lose since reigning champ RW Constitution Hill was ruled out last week. Iberico Lord could run a big race but I'll be watching how Nicky Henderson's runs in the first to see if they are back to form.
- There's really not much point in taking ages over this MC as quite clearly **STATE MAN** has to underperform not to score. **NEMEAN LION** is the each-way bet if you don't want to back the odds-on favourite.

4.50pm

JUVENILE HANDICAP HURDLE

- Connections must've been happy enough with the MF handicap mark as **LIARI** (each-way) handles soft ground fine and is a strong traveller in his races. How Milan Tino runs gives us another pointer to Sir Gino's chance on Friday.
- Plenty of good judges fancy **MILAN TINO**. His handicap PMmark looks like it could be 'generous'.
- An outsider **EAGLE FANG** could run a big each-way NC race.
- I'll chance **OSE PARTIR** based on his Christmas run at RW Leopardstown rather than a disappointing run at the Dublin Racing Festival. He should have an each-way chance.
- Nothing that grabs me here and I'm chancing MC ROARING LEGEND (each-way) for Sean Bowen and Olly Murphy who had the big Imperial Cup win with Go Dante over the weekend.

5.30pm

NATIONAL HUNT CHASE

- APPLE AWAY runs here instead of the Ultima earlier on the card and isn't without a chance as she has good chase form. MF
- CORBETTS CROSS has proven Grade 1 form and sets the standard. I ride Embassy Gardens in the race so I hope I'm PMwrong about Corbetts Cross!
- **CORBETTS CROSS** with Derek O'Connor booked to ride can get the job done. NC
- I'm with CORBETTS CROSS ahead of Embassy Gardens mainly on their running in the Albert Bartlett last season. RW
- A small field and none of these are certain stayers. SALVADOR ZIGGY did nothing in America last time but it's MC fairly easy to forgive him that run and I'll chance him for Gordon Elliott and Robert James.
