### **AINTREE HANDICAP HURDLE**

- WEST BALBOA has won at Aintree twice and was a MF dominant winner of this race last season. Ground conditions will not be a problem.
- **CUTHBERT DIBBLE** (each-way) is an improver and despite MC a 1lb hike for for third place in the Pertemps Final at Cheltenham should have an each-way chance at least.
- I'll go with a couple of bigger-priced runners **JOHNSONS** RD BLUE and HONOR GREY against the well-handicapped West Balboa.

## **AINTREE NOVICES' HURDLE**

- A high profile purchase at the sales CALDWELL MF **POTTER'S** form looks good and ground conditions are fine for him as he makes his debut for Paul Nicholls.
- **ILE ATLANTIQUE** was behind the re-opposing Jimmy MC Du Seuil when third to Ballyburn in the Baring Bingham at Cheltenham but can reverse the form.
- **BRIGHTERDAYSAHEAD** has enormous potential and RD there is little on ratings between her and former stablemate Caldwell Potter.
- WEST BALBOA drops to a mark of 141 and has a good chance. RW
- Stablemates **WEST BALBOA** and Gwennie May Boy boast TF good credentials. The former doesn't look badly treated off a mark 6 lb higher compared to when winning this in good style last year.
- FINE MARGIN'S Haydock run puts him in the driving seat. PM His last run was too bad to be true and he can bounce back off this light weight.

## **AINTREE HANDICAP CHASE**

- KINONDO KWETU (each-way) has a good record at the MF track and was third in this race last year. The drier the ground the better his chance.
- **CRUZ CONTROL** (each-way) stays well and goes in deep MC ground and is improving so must have a chance for Tom Lacey and Stan Sheppard.
- **FORWARD PLAN** could be the value pick and his running RD style is perfect for Aintree. The handicapper hasn't a hold of him yet.
- **CREBILLY** will appreciate the step up in trip to 3m 1f after a RW good run at the Festival over shorter.
- **THE KING OF RYHOPE** travelled sweetly before making a TF chance-ending blunder in an Ascot Grade 2 a couple of months ago. Dan Skelton's low-mileage eight-year-old should be bang there back in handicap company.
- **TWIG** ran a stormer at Cheltenham and that form looks strong. PM

- JIMMY DU SEUIL ran really well at Cheltenham and RW looks overpriced.
- TF The step up to 2m 4f could see **CALDWELL POTTER** in an even better light and he can prove just too strong for his half-sister and former stablemate Brighterdaysahead.
- **CALDWELL POTTER** comes here fresh and looks the PM class act with a Grade 1 win under his belt already.

### **AINTREE LIVERPOOL HURDLE**

- **STRONG LEADER** ran very well at this venue last year MF finishing second in a Grade 1 contest over 2 miles. He's taken a big step up in distance since but can out-run his odds.
- This is up for grabs. There should be a good pace on, so I'll MC give **CRAMBO** another chance although he was hopeless at Cheltenham and he needs to step up big time.
- I didn't fancy **CRAMBO** at Cheltenham (and he ran poorly) RD but he will shape better after that run. Aintree should suit him better but he's a tentative pick.
- **FLOORING PORTER** can get back to winning ways and has RW the best form on offer.
- **FLOORING PORTER** is taken to land this prize for the first TF time following a mighty effort in the Stayers' Hurdle.
- **MONKFISH** is worth another chance. His Galmoy win was PM impressive and it was a big ask in the Gold Cup. An early mistake took him out of the race.

### **AINTREE GRAND NATIONAL HANDICAP CHASE**

- MF My four against the field in the Grand National are **MEETINGOFTHEWATERS, CORACH RAMBLER,** NOBLE YEATS and PANDA BOY.
- MC The Grand National is Irish dominated and my four against the field are: I AM MAXIMUS, NOBLE YEATS, **MEETINGOFTHEWATERS** and **VANNILLER**.
- In the Grand National it's **PANDA BOY**, RD **MEETINGOFTHEWATERS** and **GALIA DES LITEAUX** that are my three against the field and the tricast!
- **CAPADANNO** (each-way) has had a better prep this season RW and can improve on last year's showing in the Grand National.
- **MAHLER MISSION** has been kept fresh since a fine second TF in the Coral Gold Cup last Autumn. The way he jumped/ travelled that day marked him down as one who will be well served by the demands of this race.
- **MEETINGOFTHEWATERS** is lightly raced and has a PM beautiful light weight. He will need to settle but if he does, he can be ahead of his mark.

### **AINTREE NOVICES' CHASE**

- HERCULE DU SEUIL is a strong traveller and good jumper MF who will revel in this test.
- **FOUND A FIFTY** chased home Gaelic Warrior in the Arkle MC and that form was given a huge boost by the impressive II Etait Temps on Thursday.
- NICKLE BACK looks overpriced. He's already bolted up in a RD Group 1 this season and he's been laid out for this.
- **MATATA** (each-way) appeals at a big price on a Flat track RW after a big run at Cheltenham.
- **FOUND A FIFTY** has been most consistent in the top 2m TF novice chases this season and can land a second win at the highest level.
- **QUILIXIOS** might as well have been a non-runner at PM Cheltenham after a bad start. He has high class form and is overpriced.
