TRIUMPH HURDLE

- ★ Ruby Walsh: I don't know why people have taken against Apple's Shakira. She's got great course and ground form. She is a worthy favourite.
- ★ Nina Carberry: Apple's Shakira hasn't done anything wrong this season. It'll be interesting to see if she shows up again.
- **★ Frank:** I am really excited about **Apple's Shakira**. She will relish the strong pace that the Triumph almost always produces.
- **★Paddy:** Oh baby when you jump like that, you make a punter go mad. So be wise and keep on reading the signs of the bookies. My tips don't lie **Apple's Shakira**. Waka waka.

COUNTY HURDLE

★ Ruby Walsh: Sandsend is interesting. He'll run a big race in this too.

- ★ Frank: Willie Mullins has won this race 4 times in 8 years and he could well improve that record here with Meri Devie.

GOLD CUP

- ★ Ruby Walsh: I think **Definitly Red** is the value on slower ground, hovering around 16/1.
- ★ Nina Carberry: Now that Sizing John isn't going, Native River can take it.
- ★ Frank: Killultagh Vic is very inexperienced for the test of a Gold Cup but he is super-talented. I think he can finally give Willie Mullins a first Gold Cup win.
- ★ Paddy: In theory it's a three-way shootout, but there's class throughout this field. **Might Bite** could be just too strong.

FOXHUNTER CHASE

- ★ Ruby Walsh: Wonderful Charm ran well last year. Paul Nicholl's put him up as his best bet of the week. Foxrock around the 7/1 mark will have to have a chance.
- ★ Nina Carberry: Burning Ambition has the most to improve, so if he does improve he'll be hard to beat.
- **★ Frank: Caid Du Berlais** has plenty of Cheltenham form, and seems sure to play a big part in a race where **Burning Ambition** looks the biggest danger.
- ★ Paddy: Wonderful Charm was a nickname given to me by my first girlfriend, so I have nostalgic leanings for that one. But I think Burning Ambition has what it takes.

MARTIN PIPE HANDICAP HURDLE

- ★ Nina Carberry: It's going to be a very hard race to pick a winner from. But I'm going with Sire Du Berlais.
- **★ Frank: Sire Du Berlais** was eyecatching at Fairyhouse, grabbing second without being given too hard of a ride.

GRAND ANNUAL

- * Ruby Walsh: I thought the horse that won it last year could go and win again, Rock The World. I think he has a great chance.
- ★ Frank: Don't Touch It hasn't been in the best of form in two runs this year but one suspects that he was being aimed to peak for the Grand Annual all along.
