FILLY AND MARE SPRINT

6.55PM

JW: **Come Dancing** has an impressive profile of 8 from 13 starts and reached a speed figure of 114 over this distance at aqueduct. A reproduction of that should be enough.

MC: It's **Covfefe** for me in this one. He's a Grade One winner and will be simply too hard to catch.

TF: **Come Dancing** boasts the best form in the field and it should show here.

T: **Covfefe** ran a 107 Beyer in her prep race for this. She has the best early speed in the race and drawn on the rail so no issues there.

PP: **Covfefe** was named after one of Trump's Twitter gaffes. Clearly, it's a banker.

TURF SPRINT

7.33pm

JW: **Pure Sensation** has a decent record when fresh and is back off a two month absence. This speedball is also drawn close to the fence so I'm expecting an easy win.
