PUNDITS' PICKS OF THE DAY











1.15pm THE BUCKINGHAM PALACE HANDICAP

- JW FLAMING SPEAR each-way at a big price for me to kick things off nicely.
- MC I will have a few quid each-way on KAESO who just loves these types of events and gets Oisin Murphy on board for Nigel Tinkler.
- MF Great to see full fields for the handicaps and I am going for a bit of value in the opening event with GREENSIDE each-way.
- FH FLAMING SPEAR is a big price for a horse that was rated 9lbs higher just a year ago. Trip, ground & draw look ideal and he looks a fair each way play.
- PP Market vibes suggested **DAARIK** was meant to come on a lot for his last run, but won impressively nonetheless. Gosden & Frankie first up, what's not to like!

1.50pm THE QUEEN ANNE STAKES (GROUP 1)

- JW SKARDU should of strengthened into his frame with another winter on his back. The yard are coming into form at just the right moment.
- MC I have to take on Circus Maximus and will risk MOHAATHER each-way at a big price. I have a feeling he's going to be very good for Marcus Tregoning at some point this term.
- **MF MUSTASHRY** beat a very good field when winning last season's Lockinge Stakes at Newbury over the straight mile. He looks a great each-way bet at the prices.
- FH MOHAATHER looked like he was going to be a big player in last year's Guineas before an injury ruled him out. Said to be working really well and he looks a fair price in an open looking event.
- PP ROSEMAN is still unexposed and if he handles the quicker ground, which I think he will, he has a massive chance at a price.

2.25PM THE RIBBLESDALE STAKES (GROUP 2)

- JW Hard to look past the favourite FRANKLY DARLING now that Born with Pride is a non runner.
- MC I have to side with the favourite FRANKLY DARLING, who impressed so many at Newcastle first time. John Gosden has a great record in the race.
- **MF FRANKLY DARLING** won nicely at Newcastle over 10f and the step up in trip is a perfect fit for this daughter of Frankel.
- FH TREFOIL looked to be crying out for this trip when third at Newmarket over 10f last week. She should improve for that run.
- PP I'm surprised that Ryan Moore chose to ride stablemate Passion over **ENNISTYMON** but sure what does he know! With the usual Aiden O'Brien improvement he could go close.



3.00pm THE KING EDWARD VII STAKES (GROUP 2)

- JW MOGUL wasn't disgraced in Group One company at Newcastle and you don't need reminding how strong that form is. He could, as they say, literally be anything.
- MC MOGUL has to be the selection here, for the legend that is Aidan O'Brien.
- **MF MOGUL** should be winning this contest if he is to be a live candidate for next month's Epsom Derby. Mohican Heights could be the danger.
- **FH MOGUL** has been touted as Coolmore's Derby horse and he has to be winning here to be a player at Epsom.
- **PP MOGUL** is banker material. If he's right, he'll win. The only doubt is that it's a Derby prep and he's not fully wound up.

3.35pm THE KING'S STAND STAKES (GROUP 1)

- JW If Battaash decides to turn up we may all be playing second fiddle but the race has a fantastic each way look about it and WELL DONE FOX is a massive price each-way.
- MC Obviously I have to be with BATTAASH, who is the best sprinter in the world when he brings his 'A' game. The only slight issue is he does not always run to his best!
- **MF** He's an odds-on favourite but **BATTAASH** has the perfect opportunity for that elusive first victory at Ascot.
- FH Battaash is the one to beat but is a short price and LIBERTY BEACH is progressive and is my each way play.
- **PP GLASS SLIPPERS** hammered the unreliable Battaash in the Abbaye, albeit on softer ground than ideal, is a sprinter on the up who should be involved in the business end of this.

4.10pm THE DUKE OF CAMBRIDGE STAKES (GROUP 2)

- JW JUBILOSO'S form around here up at the highest level in Group
 One company is by far and away the best on offer.
 MC NAZEEF is on a roll but I'll back JUBILOSO each-way for Sir
- MC NAZEEF is on a roll but I'll back JUBILOSO each-way for Sir Michael Stoute and Ryan Moore. She was third in the Coronation Stakes in 2019 and that might be good enough.
- MF LAVENDERS BLUE looks good value to hit the frame and is owned by Benny Andersson of ABBA.
- **FH LAVENDERS BLUE** is very unexposed over a mile and I think the market underestimates her chance. She is the one to beat in my eyes.
- PP NAZEEF is a solid selection who keeps improving and keeps winning. If he doesn't win, whatever beats him will have had to work hard to do it.

4.40pm THE ASCOT STAKES (HANDICAP)

- JW QULOOB ran a belter here over two miles when lumping 10 stone and was finishing off his race quite strongly. That looked an ideal prep for this test and is a big price in a tricky finale.
- MC It's DUBAWI FIFTY each-way for me for Karen McLintock and Adam Kirby. The 2018 runner-up is back on a mark to perform with aplomb once again.
- **MF** I'll take a punt with **BLUE LAUREATE** each-way for trainer lan Williams. He was second at Haydock last week so should be fighting fit and can run a big race.
- **FH PIANISSIMO** is still quite unexposed and is two from four in handicaps, while his recent start was no more than a prep run for this race. Frankie Dettori is booked.
- PP A jumps trainer usually wins this and VERDANA BLUE is the best hurdler in the race by some way. She might lap them!
