1.50pm <

WOODCOTE EBF STAKES 6F

- He looked an improver in the making when winning on debut and TWAASOL can build on that now.
- MC TWAASOL looked a bright prospect on debut at Windsor for Owen Burrows and could be very useful.
- TWAASOL showed lots of promise when winning at MF Windsor and gets my vote in the opener.
- I wouldn't be shocked if CALCUTTA CUP is up to winning this on debut for Andrew Balding.
- MODERN NEWS was disappointing at Ascot but the PP drop back to 6f is enough for me to forgive and forget.

3.00pm <

INVESTEC HANDICAP 1M 2F

- He's improved every year and his record when fresh is decent so **CARADOC** is my pick.
- MC I like CARADOC here for trainer Ed Walker each-way. He will be suited by a decent pace to run at in this big field under champion jockey Oisin Murphy.
- If CARADOC is sharp enough on his first run of the season he can win this contest.
- He may want faster ground, but CARADOC is definitely well handicapped off a mark of 100 and Oisin Murphy is booked to ride.
- PP Based on his recent Newmarket romp DESERT ICON looks well ahead of the handicapper. Hard to see beyond him winning.

4.15pm

PRINCESS ELIZABETH STAKES 1M

- This is a tougher race than the ones she's won but FOORAAT looks well equipped to deal with it.
- MC The market leaders have questions to answer so I'm going for LOVE AND THUNDER for the Gosden and Dettori combo again.
- FOORAAT was impressive at Chelmsford and looks is uncomplicated which is massive plus around Epsom's tight and undulating track.
- FOORAAT nearly broke the clock when winning at Chelmsford. She steps up in grade but can take it in her stride.
- FOORAAT is unbeaten and could be anything based on his seven-length win at Chelmsford. Main market rival Cloak of Spirits could have gone a bit backwards.



2.25pm -

SURREY STAKES 7F

- The form of his comeback run has been franked and SAFE VOYAGE can gain an overdue success.
- Hard to get away from SAFE VOYAGE here who has MC the highest rating and the best form.
- SAFE VOYAGE looks the most solid option and more rain will only enhance his chance.
- OH THIS IS US has some solid course form and if he gets the run of the race can pounce late to win.
- OH THIS IS US was a bit unlucky to be second in this race last year, so we know he handles the track well.

3.40pm

INVESTEC OAKS 1M 4F

- Her 1,000 Guineas win was awesome and LOVE could be the first leg of a massive Classic double for the Aidan O'Brien team
- MC The Epsom Oaks is over 1m 4f and I am all over FRANKLY DARLING for Frankie Dettori and John Gosden. The favourite Love will have to stay on strongly to beat her.
- Aidan O'Brien holds all the aces and LOVE can win but stablemate Ennistymon can hit the places.
- Aidan O'Brien's ENNISTYMON looks rock solid each-way value and could even surprise to win.
- ENNISTYMON will need to can find a couple of lengths on her Ascot run to trouble Frankly Darling and Love but looks an each-way steal, if there is such a thing.

INVESTEC DERBY IM 4F

- JW I'm not sure that Kameko will stay the 1m 4f Derby trip and MOGUL can take advantage.
- I'm all over ENGLISH KING to win this year's Epsom Derby. He can outstay 2,00 Guineas winner Kameko with Russian Emperor the each-way bet at longer odds.
- ME The 2,000 Guineas winner KAMEKO has the class to win the Derby while Vatican City is one for the places
- I'm convinced ENGLISH KING is the best horse in the race and will take all the beating with a clear run as the stall one draw hasn't been kind.
 - I really liked how VATICAN CITY stayed on behind Siskin in the Irish 2000 Guineas. He's crying out for this 1m 4f trip and looks a decent bit of value in the Derby.

5.35pm

INVESTEC ZEBRA HANDICAP 7F

- MEDIEVAL has slipped down the handicap, carries a feather-weight and can go well at a decent each-way price.
- MC COMIN THROUGH was once rated much higher but he showed a bit more last time at Newmarket and this could be very winnable. Trip is ideal.
- DREAM TODAY put in a nice run at Windsor last time and dropped to a rating he has won off before.
- HATEYA was beaten a short head in this race last year and looks sure to go well each-way again.
- PP MUNTADAB has been knocking on the door in his last couple of runs. Hopefully his time has come in the lucky last on Derby day.
