PUNDITS' PICKS OF THE DAY











1.45pm

HANDICAP 5F

- Course winer SOLDIER'S MINUTE has had 28 lifetime JW starts but only four over 5f. An each-way player.
- ARECIBO is a pain in the backside for me as he's such MC a well handicapped horse but rarely wins. I have to give him another chance though.
- **HYPERFOCUS** has dropped to a really good mark and MF was a good second at this track last October.
- JAWAAL's win in a red-hot Ascot handicap last month TF was impressive and he can complete his hat-trick.
- PP **ARECIBO** has gone close over course and distance on good ground. It's a bit of a cavalry charge, but he should be in the mix.

2.45pm

GREAT VOLTIGUER STAKES 1M 4F

- MOGUL finally got his career back on track last time at JW Goodwood and is getting better with each race.
- It's hard to oppose MOGUL after he bounced back to MC his best at Goodwood last time in the Gordon Stakes. He's not unbeatable but is clearly a good colt.
- PYLEDRIVER won the king Edward VII Stakes at MF Royal Ascot but was disappointing in the Epsom Derby. This is a good chance to bounce back.
- **MOGUL** is taken to confirm the placings with Highland TF Chief and Subjectivist. Highly-promising novice winners Darain and Roberto Escobarr add serious intrigue to the race.
- PP **MOGUL** finally getting the job done last time. He's learned how to win and might go in again.

3.45pm

SKY BET STAKES 2M

- BLAKENEY POINT won a novice hurdle last time and JW is definitely well handicapped now back on the Flat and can go well at a juicy each-way price.
- MAKAWEE has been running well enough over shorter MC distances to have every chance of at least reaching a place in this competitive heat.
- **VOLCANIC SKY** looked good when winning at MF Kempton and back on turf could be the answer.
- MONSIEUR LAMBRAYS is two wins from two since TF the put a visor on and this course and distance winer can bring up the hat-trick.
- PP **TRUE DESTINY** has had one visit to York and one win, the Ryan Moore booking also catches the eye.

2.15pm

TATTERSALLS ACOMB STAKES 7F

- PRAISE OF SHADOWNS was a winner last time for a JW stable whose runers usually improve for a first outing.
- ROYAL SCIMITAR won in tenacious style on his debut MC at Newbury and the runner-up has since gone in twice. The extra 1f here will be ideal.
- Trainer Karl Burke really likes SPYCATCHER and he's MF a big each-way price. Royal Scimitar looks the obvious pick of those at the head of the market.
- **CLOUDBRIDGE** looked a fine prospect when winning TF on debut at Leicester earlier this month and that form has been franked. Has more to offer for Godolphin.
- Hard to know how good some of the form is but **GEAR** PP **UP** has won first time up over course and distance so might have some small advantage.

3.15pm

JUDDMONTE INTERNATIONAL 1M 2F

- KAMEKO can make up for his Goodwood fail on this JW his first try over this 10f trip and will love having the front-running Ghaiyyath as a target to aim at.
- It's hard not to see GHAIYYATH having an easy lead MC as Rose of Kildare is not good enough to lead him for very long. The Coronation Cup and Eclipse winner is very hard to oppose.
- **GHAIYYATH** has looked so good this year and he will MF be hard to beat as long as Rose of Kildare doesn't upset him by taking him on for the lead.
- Very hard to oppose **GHAIYYATH**, who is established TF as the clear leader in this division by winning his last two starts impressively.
- PP **GHAIYYATH** has turned into a top-class horse, who front runs. York should suit his style.

4.20pm

FILLIES HANDICAP 5F

- GLAMOROUS ANNA is quirky, but talented and can JW continue her climb up the ratings ladder by bringing up the hat-trick.
- **DANCIN INTHESTREET** was disappointing last time MC but had decent form prior to that effort.
- MF **KEEP BUSY** can follow up his Hamilton win last time.
- DANCIN INTHESTREET had been shaping up well in TF some good sprint handicaps prior to a disappointing run last time. She's well worth another chance returning to this level at what could be a nice price.
- **DANDY'S BEANO** was a bit all over the shop last time PP when finishing second at Haydock. If she can keep a straighter line she has a massive chance now!

4.50pm

NURSERY HANDICAP 6F

- **TOUSSAROK** bumped into a good one last time when JW second to Darvel (who runs in the the 14:15 on this card) and that should give us a good guide.
- CHURCHILL BAY has yet to win but was a fine second MC at Ascot and has a decent racing weight.
- **PEROTTO** has two wins in four starts over both 5f & 6f MF and can make it three from five in this 6f contest.
- TF CHURCHILL BAY was just touched off by a Richard Hannon newcomer Mohawk King at Ascot last month and has the potential to prove his opening mark is a fair one.
- LINE OF DEPARTURE has found the winning groove PP and can continue it here in a tricky looking nursery.
