PUNDITS' PICKS OF THE DAY

SATURDAY RACING CHEAT SHEET



1.50pm

DONCASTER - CHAMPAGNE STAKES

- ALBASHEER comes back to the same track where he JW put up a spectacular performance on his racecourse debut when winning by more than six lengths.
- I was hugely impressed with CHINDIT at Ascot last MC time and expect him to land this with ease for Richard Hannon and Pat Dobbs.
- CHINDIT was very impressive at Ascot on fast ground. MF The form from that win looks even more impressive now as second, third and fourth have all won since.
- **CHINDIT** has looked well above-average in winning TF both his starts to date and can improve again to give his yard successive wins in this event.

2.05pm

CHESTER - STAND CUP

- ALIGNAK has already proven himself a decent JW performer on 2020's form and this test may well suit him better than the market suggests.
- **MORANDO** is often a horse to take on, but everything MC is right for a big effort here from him. This distance is perfect, he has good course form and a high rating.
- MORANDO beat Kew Gardens at Chester on slowish MF ground so form at the track swings it for me.
- ALIGNAK didn't look out of place in Group company TF when third to St Leger candidate Hukum at Newbury. He should prove a tough nut to crack. The stars are aligning for ALIGNAK after strong runs at PP Newbury and Haydock, as well as a win on Newcastle's AW track to open the season.
- He battered the field on debut at Doncaster back in July PP so ALBASHEER has to be the one for me.

2.25pm

DONCASTER - PORTLAND HANDICAP

- First time **STONE OF DESTINY** is tested at 5¹/₂f and it JW looks ideal. Drawn very close to the front-running Ornate, he should get a lead at the business end.
- I tipped A MOMENTOFMADNESS in this last year and MC we'll go with him again. He was second last year off 4lbs higher and won it off 8lbs more in 2018.
- A MOMENTOFMADNESS won this two years ago, MF and was second to Group 1 winner Oxted in 2019.
- Preference is for A MOMENTOFMADNESS who won TF this race in 2018 and found only July Cup winner Oxted too good 12 months ago.
- SOLDIERS MINUTE had me standing to attention PP when he ran Acclaim the Nation close at York last time, and only has 1lb extra here.

3.00pm

DONCASTER - PARK STAKES

- **ONE MASTER** wasn't suited to the front-running track JW at York last time, but a strong pace is expected in this, so the Group 1 star should have a class edge.
- **ONE MASTER** and Limato are specialist 7f performers MC and both have a great chance here. I'm going for the former, who was brilliant at Goodwood this year. Aidan O'Brien's WICHITA runs in this. Third at Royal MF Ascot to Group 1 winner Palace Pier and second in the Guineas to Kameko, he should be better than the rest. The Criterion Stakes panned out perfectly for LIMATO TF when he landed it for the second year running in June, but that does show he's still capable despite his age. With Frankie on board, WICHITA can bounce back PP from disappointments at Goodwood and Deauville.

2.40pm

CHESTER - COMMONHALL STREET HANDICAP

- The track here will suit **MAYDANNY** as he is a real JW handy balanced type. He may even pinch this on the front end as the contest doesn't look loaded with pace.
- **RESTORER** is high in the weights now and should MC appreciate the drop in trip after disappointing over further last time.
- MF **MAYDANNY** is a smart performer who bombed out at York. I am forgiving him that run
- MAYDANNY was unsuited to York's conditions three TF weeks ago and is better judged on an impressive Goodwood showing where he looked a pattern-class performer in the making.
- Just beaten by Audarya at Newcastle over the same PP distance last time, **PREJUDICE** and can go one better.

3.10pm

LEOPARDSTOWN - MATRON STAKES

PEACEFUL and Fancy Blue have been taking it in JW turns to get to the winners enclosure. In the Matron Stakes it could be Peaceful's time again. I'll take ALBIGNA as an each-way shout. She has MC failed to shine this season and was poor last time at the Curragh, but I have always been a fan and hope Shane Foley can get a tune out of her again. FANCY BLUE is the choice of Ryan Moore and she MF has gone from strength to strength as the season has gone on. Can FANCY BLUE repeat the level of form she has TF shown over 1¹/₄m at 1m? The trip looks a disadvantage but she has won Group 1s on her last two starts. Coming back down in distance after a French trip, PP **PEACEFUL** can edge ahead of Fancy Blue again here.

3.35pm

DONCASTER - PERTEMPS ST LEGER

- **PYLEDRIVER** is a massive underdog story, but his JW jockey is very confident and like all top-class horses, he not only has stamina but a change of gear late on.
- Very good in the Queen's Vase and Irish Derby, MC SANTIAGO was far from disgraced by Stradivarius in the Goodwood Cup. He'll take some beating here.
- I'm a huge fan of **PYLEDRIVER** after wins in the Great MF Voltigeur at York and King Edward at Royal Ascot. He can deliver William Muir's first Group 1 win here.
- TF **HUKUM** looked a bona-fide Group 1 performer in the Geoffrey Freer at Newbury and this test should suit.
- GALILEO CHROME has won all three starts this PP season, and can shine for Joseph O'Brien again here.



4.10pm

LEOPARDSTOWN - IRISH CHAMPION STAKES

- If they don't give Ghaiyyath an easy time on the JW front-end, SOTTSASS can pounce late. Third in last year's Arc, he is blessed with the best change of gear in the field.
- In a small field it's hard to oppose the world's top rated MC horse GHAIYYATH once again. He should dictate easily and this track is good for front runners.
- **GHAIYYATH** is a monster and can lead it here, which MF takes away the worry of him being involved in a tactical war with the Irish trained horses.
- **GHAIYYATH** is confidently expected to maintain his TF unbeaten record in 2020 and make it win number five with another all-the-way victory.
- I can't look beyond GHAIYYATH and that unbeaten PP 2020 record should continue



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
