GRADE 2 TRIUMPH HURDLE TRIAL 2M

- FH HELL RED made a big impression on his stable debut & he can take this step up in grade in his stride.
- MC HELL RED was very impressive at Chepstow and will be hard to stop in a wide-open race..
- I have been really impressed with **DUFFLE COAT**. He's not very big but is tough.
- TF HELL RED made light work of landing a juvenile at Chepstow on his first start in this country and can take advantage of the 5lbs he gets off Duffle Coat.
- PP HELL RED looked pretty good to me when hacking up at Chepstow and trainer Paul Nicholls is flying.

GRADE 2 FTHM NOVICES CHASE 2M

- I really liked **ELDORADO ALLENs** debut chase win and while he needs to improve to win he can.
- MC The most talented is **FUSIL RAFFLES** and his experience in winning two chases will help.
- MF QUEL DESTIN could be the value play agains tFusil Raffles especially on softer ground.
- TF FUSIL RAFFLES won an uncompetitive race last month over C&D in an excellent time that adds substance to the form.
- PP Fusil Raffles will be hard to beat but Henry De Bromhead won this contest last year with subsequent Arkle winner Put The Kettle On and saddles ZARKAREVA.

PADDY POWER GAMES H'CAP H'DLE 3M

- FH DANDY DAN looks to be on a fair mark returning to hurdles with the Kim Bailey yard in great nick.
- MC TOBEFAIR was third in this contest last year off a mark of 154 and is 3lb lower this time. Each-way player.
- MF TEA CLIPPER was impressive when winning at Chepstow and can go close again.
- There should be more to come from **TEA CLIPPER** now stepping up to 3m and he can defy the handicapper again and make it five wins from only six starts.
- PP MRS MILNER is a Galway festival winner and this stamina test is sure to suit. Paul Nolan's raiders are always worth keeping onside.

- FH KILFILIUM CROSS finished second in the past two runnings of the Kim Muir and a spin at Fakenham should leave him spot on for this.
- MC PETITE POWER is an out-and-out stayer and might plod into a place. He needed the run on his comeback.
- MF OCEAN COVER has form on soft and there is plenty of rain forecast. Good each-way chance.
- TF KILFILUM CROSS ran a cracker when runner-up in last year's Kim Muir here and should be spot on after his recent reappearance.
- PP Richard Patrick rides STORM CONTROL. He's as good an amateur as you'll get around here

- The Paddy Power Gold Cup is a great race and **SIMPLY THE BETTS** is the one I'm siding with.
- TF SIMPLY THE BETTS looks the type that will progress out of handicaps this season and can remain unbeaten over the Cheltenham fences.
- PP AL DANCER has good track form and was a convincing winner last time, he also tends to do his winning at this time of year. Stable just hitting form too.

- **FH SON OF CAMAS** loks nicely handicapped off 133 and a wind operation can help him return to winning ways.
- MC CAPTAIN TOM CAT destoyed his field at this track last time. He's up 6lb but if in the same sort of form he's going to be hard to stop again.
- MF Nicky Henderson's SON OF CAMAS can make light of his handicap mark in Paddy's first 'Millionaire' qualifier.
- TF TOPOFTHECOTSWOLDS ran a fine race in a decent C&D novice hurdle last month and seems sure to give it another good go on this switch to handicaps.
- This is the the first of our 'Millionaire' qualifier races and Nicky Henderson's **SON OF CAMAS** looks like a handicap snip on his best form.

MARES' NH FLAT RACE 2M

- Anthony Honeyball's yard is banging in the winners and **UCANAVER** can add another winner for him.
- MC A lot of guesswork here but **ELLE EST BELLE** has already looked very good for Dan and Harry Skelton when oozing class although this is tougher.
- MF Dan Skelton's **ELLE EST BELLE** sets the standard but Allavina looks the each-way play.
- TF ELLE EST BELLE is just about the most persuasive option as she beat 4 last-time-out winners when sweeping from last to first at Aintree 3 weeks ago.
- **PP UCANAVER** won his last bumper by 20 lenghts and the second was 18 lengths clear of the third that's quite far! Oh, and the Honeyball stable is in form too.
