CHAMPION DAY, TUES MARCH 16TH

1.20 SUPREME NOVICES HURDLE

Appreciate It looks rock solid here. He's only been beaten once, and that was by Ferny Hollow in last year's Champion Bumper I.

1.55 ARKLE CHASE

It looks a three-horse race to me, with **Shishkin**, Energumene and Allmankind. Shiskin has the strongest form, will sit in behind and pounce.

2.30 ULTIMA HANDICAP CHASE

If Farclas runs in this he'd have a really good chance but **Escaria Ten** could be the stable's main hope.

3.05 CHAMPION HURDLE

If I was given a ride in this year's race, I would choose **Honeysuckle**. She has been better than ever this season and her performance blew me away in the Irish Champion Hurdle.

3.40 MARES HURDLE

Wille Mullins has won nine of the 13 runnings of this race and **Concertista** can add to that record now. She won the Mares Novices' Hurdle here very impressively last season.

4.15 BOODLES JUVENILE HANDICAP HURDLE

Coltor is well fancied for Dermot Weld. Cabot Cliffs from Dan Skelton is also well thought of, but I'm going with **Hous Gris** here for Paul Nicholls. Busselton for Joseph O'Brien could also come into the equation.

4.50 NATIONAL HUNT CHASE

Royale Pagaille's performance at Haydock was outstanding and he should take all the beating. Galvin could be an alternative and has been aimed at this contest all season.

LADIES DAY, WED MARCH 17TH

1.20 BALLYMORE NOVICES HURDLE

Gaillard Du Mesnil, Bob Olinger and Bravemansgame set the standard here. I really fancy **Bob Olinger** based on his Naas win.

1.55 BROWN ADVISORY NOVICES' CHASE

Monkfish is the banker bet for many this week. He's been flawless all season long.

2.30 CORAL CUP

I'd give **Birchdale** a fair each-way chance in this contest. He was eighth in this race last year but has had a better preparation this time and is rated 2lbs lower.

3.05 QUEEN MOTHER CHAMPION CHASE

I'll be bitterly disappointed if **Chacun Pour Soi** doesn't win. Same trainer, owner and jockey as Monkfish. First Flow could be value each-way.

3.40 GLENFARCLAS CHASE

Easysland will be the one and only French winner at this year's festival.

4.15 GRAND ANNUAL CHASE

He has a lot of different entries this week, but **The Shunter** is my pick if he runs here. This race is now run on the old course, which should suit those ridden up near the pace. He's a good chance of claiming the £100,000 bonus after winning at Kelso.

4.50 CHAMPION BUMPER

Ramillies could be the each-way value against his two better fancied stablemates. If ridden a little more conservatively, I can see him hitting the frame.

DAY THREE

ST PATRICK'S THURSDAY, MARCH 18TH

1.20 MARSH NOVICES' CHASE

I'm going with **Envoi Allen**. He's unbeaten and look the best we've seen for a while

1.55 PERTEMPS NETWORK FINAL

I never won this race as a jockey and I don't remember having too many near misses either!

The Bosses Oscar has been targeted at this all season, but it is a speculative pick.

2.30 RYANAIR CHASE

Last year's winner **Min** can win again. He has achieved the most in his career from the others in the field.

3.05 PADDY POWER STAYERS' HURDLE

With Thyme Hill out it's going to make Paisley Park a short favourite, but I'm going to go with **Sire Du Berlais**. His Pertemps performance last year was outstanding and he's my pick.

3.40 PADDY POWER PLATE

A tricky handicap where **Fils D'oudairies** can go close for Joseph O' Brien. He was a good winner at Navan and chased home Envoi

4.15 MARES NOVICES HURDLE

This can go the way of one of the smaller yards. I fancy Peter Fahey's **Royal Kahala**.

4.50 KIM MUIR CHALLENGE CUP

Time To Get Up is my pick. A winner last time but his back form shows he was second to Monkfish in a maiden hurdle in 2019. That will do for me.

DAY FOUR

GOLD CUP DAY, FRI MARCH 19TH

1.20 TRIUMPH HURDLE

Zanahiyr and recent Adonis Hurdle winner Tritonic set the standard. I really fancy **Zanahiyr** who blew me away when he beat Saint Sam by 14 lengths at Fairyhouse and again at Leopardstown.

1.55 COUNTY HANDICAP HURDLE

Ganapathai looks to have a live chance. He's a novice on a rating of 140, a good jumper and is progressing. The track and the trip should suit.

2.30 ALBERT BARTLETT NOVICES HURDLE

I like the way Paul Nicholls' Barbados Buck's has been winning his races but **N'golo** could be suited by the trip up to three miles and has a good each-way chance for Willie Mullins.

3.05 GOLD CUP

The hand of history is on **Al Boum Photo** as he looks to emulate Best Mate in recent times and win his third Gold Cup in a row. He's been there, done that at this track and the 3m 2f trip, but you can't say that yet about Champ and A Plus Tard.

3.40 FOXHUNTERS CHASE

Billaway had an advantage when Patrick Mullins was due to ride him but that's gone now. Paul Nicholls' **Bob and Co** look a viable alternative.

4.15 THE MRS PADDY POWER MARES CHASE

A competitive contest for the new race on the card. There's lots of really good mares in it but I love **Elimay**. She will be really hard to beat.

4.50 MARTIN PIPE HURDLE

The final race of the Cheltenham Festival and it can go the way of Willie Mullins' **Galopin Des Champs**. The step up to 2m 4f now should suit.

He's got a great each-way chance.
