- THIRD TIME LUCKI paid the price for an early move TF in the County Hurdle but makes a strong case for compensation now.
- Nicky Henderson has won this contest four times in the last eight years and **DUSART** can score for him again now.
- I'm hoping THIRD TIME LUCKI can reverse County MC Hurdle form with Belfast Banter as he's now 14lbs better off at the weights.

- THE BIG BREAKAWAY should appreciate the MC drying ground and looks an each-way play.

- CARIBEAN BOY caught the eye in the Paddy Power Plate at the Cheltenham Festival and heads a strong entry for Nicky Henderson who has won this contest five times.
- PRECIOUS CARGO ran well last time after a wind FΗ operation and can go well at a price.
- This should be more to the liking of **MORNING** MC **VICAR** who didn't see out the longer trip at Cheltenham and will also appreciate the better ground now.
