- TF GETAWAY TRUMP has been called a few names in his time but it's hard to knock his record over 2m on good ground and he's taken to build on his comfortable Doncaster win last time.
- FH GREY DIAMOND won easily last time and looks set to relish decent ground for trainer-in-form Sam Thomas.
- MC The Grand Annual fourth ON THE SLOPES is very well suited to a big-runner field over the minimum two mile trip. Should give us a good run.
