Largy Debut looked to have the world at his feet when beating Kilcruit at Cork, but it hasn't worked out that way. Willie Mullins has three declared to run but the one that stands out to me is Nicky Henderson's UK challenger FILS D'OUDAIRIES on his Ascot ad Aintree form.

GRADE 1 3M IRISH MIRROR NOVICE 5.20pm

A really good Grade 1 where THE NICE GUY takes an unbeaten record into the race after his Cheltenham win in the Albert Bartlett Novices' Hurdle. He may have improved again and can uphold the form with Minella Cocooner and Bardenstown Lad.

GRADE 13M PUNCHESTOWN GOLD CUP 5.55рм

Allaho steps up to three miles again having had five runs over this trip and winning just once at Clonmel over hurdles. He's a more relaxed horse now and I think he'll stay. It's sure to be a strongly run race with him in it. Clan Des Obeaux will push him all the way, but ALLAHO could be too strong for them all if he stays the trip.

The Champion Bumper winner FACILE VEGA could improve for the better ground at Punchestown as he had to do it the hard way at Cheltenham. He can maintain his unbeaten record.

Four runners for Willie Mullins and CIEL DE NEIGE could be the best of them under Mark Walsh. He's very consistent, a course winner and the step up in trip to 2m 5f should really suit him.

Willie Mullins has another four runners in this graded mares' bumper, but he may have to settle for the places behind Peter Fahey's BATTLING BESSIE who has some decent back form.
