1.30pm SUPREME NOVICES' HURDLE, 2M1/2F (GRADE 1)

High Definition and FACILE VEGA had a right buckle at the Dublin Racing Festival until High Definition unseated his rider at half-way and Facile Vega then faded to finish fifth at the end. It was his first defeat and I'm not opposing Facile Vega now.

2.10pm ARKLE CHASE, 2M (GRADE 1)

The home team have Jonbon who is unbeaten over fences as is El Fabiolo who heads a strong Irish challenge. The more I look at the pace angle I'm inclined to think **SAINT ROI** Looks a good each-way bet if the others fold on the run in.

2.50PM HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (3M1F)

The first handicap of the four-day meeting and it's a very competitive puzzle to solve. Irish runners don't have a great record in this race. Venetia Williams' FANION D'ESTRUVAL drops to handicap company and is an each-way price.

3.30pm CHAMPION HURDLE, 2M1/2F (GRADE 1)

It looks a match between the unbeaten Constitution Hill and State Man. **CONSTITUTION HILL** will be long odds-on and State Man will follow him home. There's no other real value to be had here.

4.10pm MARES' HURDLE, 2M4F (GRADE 1)

Honeysuckle is the star attraction but this is a race Willie Mullins has farmed and **BRANDY LOVE** should improve plenty for her first run of the season at Punchestown a few weeks ago. I like **SHEWEARSITWELL** as an each-way option.

4.50PM BOODLES JUVENILE H'CAP H'DLE (2M1/2F)

Team Mullins hit the post last year when Gaelic Warrior was just denied in this contest and stablemate **TEKAO** in the JP McManus colours can go one better now.

5.30pm NATIONAL HUNT CHASE, 3M6F (GRADE 2)

Willie Mullins and his son Paddy, have already won twice.
