## 2.55PM AINTREE BOWL CHASE (3M 1F)

I've landed on **AHOY SENOR** who has had success at Aintree. His fall at Cheltenham was coming but I assume he's schooled well since. There should be enough left in the tank.

## 3.30PM AINTREE HURDLE (2M 4F)

It's a question of how many lengths will **CONSTITUTION HILL** win by? He's going to bolt up once again so I like him to win by 12 lengths or more.

## 4.05PM FOXHUNTERS OPEN CHASE (2M 5F)

Winged Leader is a very good horse and arguably the most likely winner but I'm going with **NOT THAT FUISSE** as a value pick. This distance will suit him.

## 4.40PM RED RUM HANDICAP CHASE (2M)

Dancing On My Own was second in this last year behind The Last Day but now has a higher handicap mark, which is a joke. I'll go with **THE LAST DAY** for that reason.

## 5.15PM NICKEL COIN MARES' NHF (2M 1F)
